

Html Paragraph / Formating

HTML documents are divided into paragraphs.

HTML Paragraphs

Paragraphs are defined with the <p> tag.

Example

<pre><html> <body> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> </body> </html></pre>	<p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p>

Note: Browsers automatically add an empty line before and after a paragraph.

Don't Forget the End Tag

Most browsers will display HTML correctly even if you forget the end tag:

<pre><html> <body> <p>This is a paragraph. <p>This is a paragraph. <p>This is a paragraph. <p>Don't forget to close your HTML tags! </p> </body> </html></pre>	<p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>This is a paragraph.</p> <p>Don't forget to close your HTML tags!</p>

HTML Output - Useful Tips

You cannot be sure how HTML will be displayed. Large or small screens, and resized windows will create different results.

With HTML, you cannot change the output by adding extra spaces or extra lines in your HTML code.

The browser will remove extra spaces and extra lines when the page is displayed. Any number of lines count as one line, and any number of spaces count as one space.

HTML Text Formatting

<pre><html> <body> <p>This text is bold</p> <p>This text is strong</p> <p><big>This text is big</big></p> <p><i>This text is italic</i></p></pre>	<p>This text is bold</p> <p>This text is strong</p> <p>This text is big</p> <p><i>This text is italic</i></p>

<pre> <p>This text is emphasized</p> <p><code>This is computer output</code></p> <p>This is<sub> subscript</sub> and <sup>superscript</sup></p> </body> </html> </pre>	<p><i>This text is emphasized</i></p> <p>This is computer output</p> <p>This is ^{subscript} and ^{superscript}</p>

HTML Text Formatting Tags

Tag	Description
	Defines bold text
<big>	Defines big text
	Defines emphasized text
<i>	Defines small text
<small>	Defines strong text
<sub>	Defines subscripted text
<sup>	Defines superscripted text
<ins>	Defines inserted text
	Defines deleted text
